Who we help...

ON THE MOVE MINISTRY HELPS THE DISABLED, DISPLACED, AND DISADVANTAGED MEMBERS OF OUR COMMUNITY WHO ARE TRANSITIONING OUT OF HOMELESSNESS.

HOMELESSNESS IS OFTEN A RESULT OF CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND SOMEONE'S CONTROL. UNEMPLOYMENT, HIGH HOUSING COSTS, WOMEN AND CHILDREN FLEEING DOMESTIC ABUSE, MENTAL AND PHYSICAL HEALTH CONDITIONS ARE AMONG THE TOP REASONS PEOPLE FACE HOMELESSNESS. MANY WHO FIND THEMSELVES HOMELESS DESIRE AND DREAM OF A BETTER LIFE, BUT THEY NEED HELP GETTING STARTED.



Why we help...

WE HELP IN OBEDIENCE TO GOD'S CALLING ON EACH OF US TO SERVE THOSE IN NEED.

WE ARE THE HANDS AND FEFT OF JESUS AND ALL THAT WE DO IS FOR HIS HONOR AND GLORY.

SECURING AN APARTMENT OR HOUSE IS THE FIRST STEP OUT OF HOMELESSNESS, BUT TO MAKE A HOME REQUIRES MORE THAN JUST 4 WALLS. WITH NO BED TO SLEEP IN, NO FOOD IN THE CUPBOARD, AND NO POT TO COOK IT IN, THESE INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES ARE STILL IN CRISIS. MOST DO NOT HAVE THE FINANCIAL NOR TRANSPORTATION MEANS TO ESTABLISH A HOME. UNLESS SOMEONE STEPS IN TO HELP FURNISH THEIR HOME AND CUPBOARDS, THESE PRECIOUS PEOPLE ARE STILL NOT **HOME**.

How you can help...

THERE ARE SEVERAL WAYS YOU CAN HELP BLESS THE LIVES OF THOSE TRANSITIONING OUT OF HOMELESSNESS:

- VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED TO HELP PICK UP AND DELIVER FURNITURE.
- DONATIONS OF CLEAN, EXCELLENT CONDITION, APARTMENT-SIZED FURNITURE IS ALWAYS NEEDED
- FINANCIAL DONATIONS TO COVER THE COST OF NEW BEDS AND FURNISHINGS ARE ALSO APPRECIATED AND WELCOMED. IN ADDITION TO DONATED FURNITURE, IT COSTS AN AVERAGE OF \$600 TO PROVIDE A BED AND FURNISHINGS FOR AN INDIVIDUAL'S HOME.

What we provide...

DEPENDING ON THE SIZE OF THE APARTMENT/HOUSE, EACH CLIENT IS PROVIDED WITH A RECLINER OR COUCH. END TABLE. KITCHEN TABLE OR TV TRAY. DRESSER AND A NEW BED.

THOUGH WE SEEK DONATED FURNITURE, WE TRY TO PROVIDE A NEW MATTRESS AND BOX SPRING. CURRENTLY A NEW TWIN BED COSTS AND AVERAGE OF **\$300.00**.

IN ADDITION TO FURNITURE, WE PROVIDE EACH CLIENT A **HOME BUNDLE** WHICH ALSO COSTS **\$350** AND INCLUDES:

- MATTRESS PAD. SHEETS. PILLOW. AND BLANKET
- SHOWER CURTAIN AND HOOKS, TOWEL SET, TOILET PAPER, AND HYGIENE SUPPLIES
- POTS & PANS, TOASTER, DISHES, GLASSES, SILVERWARE, KITCHEN UTENSILS, BAKING PAN, CUTTING BOARD, MIXING BOWL, KITCHEN TOWEL, AND HOT PAD
- LAUNDRY BASKET, CLEANING PRODUCTS, BROOM AND DUSTPAN, PAPER TOWEL, FOIL,
 AND PLASTIC WRAP
- AN INITIAL SUPPLY OF FOOD ITEMS
- LAMPS AS NEEDED
- A BIBLE

COMBINED (IN ADDITION TO THE DONATED FURNITURE)

IT COSTS A TOTAL OF \$650 TO PROVIDE WHAT IS NEEDED TO ESTABLISH A HOME.
